Gauteng's Reddam House schools top the charts in matric results

The Class of 2020 matriculants at [Reddam House](#) schools in South Africa, part of the international [Inspired Education Group](#), has again achieved a 100% pass rate in the Independent Examinations Board (IEB) national examinations at all of their eight schools in three provinces.

The three Reddam House schools in Gauteng delivered above average results across the board. A total of 169 students completed the IEB exams, achieving 352 distinctions between them. 17 students achieved seven or more distinctions and seven achieved six. 37 students achieved an A-aggregate and 90 achieved an A- or B-aggregate, with 38 ranking in the top 1% of IEB candidates per subject nationally.

The top achievers in the Gauteng Reddam House schools were Nicolas Andersch from Reddam House Bedfordview, Saneshan Reddy from Reddam House Helderfontein and Reuben Klopper from Reddam House Waterfall with eight distinctions a piece.

88 Reddam House Bedfordview students achieved 186 subject distinctions, with 61% of the grade obtaining A or B-aggregates.

Reddam House Waterfall matriculants obtained a total of 92 subject distinctions, with 10 students achieving four or more distinctions. Reuben Klopper earned eight, and Katja van Dyk, Kaela Kokkas, Nakeisha Reddy, and Rahul Nundlall each achieved seven distinctions.

Reddam House Helderfontein in Fourways applauded several of their matriculants for all-round achievements while living out the Reddam House motto of *We Shall Give Back*. They include Esther Cuba, who joined Helderfontein on a scholarship. She settled quickly, worked hard, and became an integral part of the school family.

Three exceptional students who joined Reddam House Helderfontein in Grade 11 were Craig Goredema; Dominic Bayne and Saneshan Reddy, who became close friends. Saneshan, a wonderful all-rounder and a member of the Senior Executive, thrived with a mix of subjects including AP Maths and AP English, Drama, and Physical Sciences. Dominic Bayne spent his Grade 10 year in Italy. He started his matric year in 14th position in the grade and with intense determination and hard work, ended in first place. The trio plan to attend the University of Stellenbosch together studying Business, IT and Actuarial Sciences respectively, aiming to open a business together in the near future.
